## ALET DAVY : CRAZY STAINED GLASS:

Examples of different ways to achieve stained glass effects on quilts, will be shown and discussed. Students will then make a crazy stained glass block, on a material and batting foundation. Different ways of joining these blocks and to work of the edges will be shown.

Various articles, like cushions, wall hangings and even bed quilts can be made with these blocks.

Techniques: Foundation stitching on material and batting.
Stitch and flip method, with folded strips to stich the material down.

Squaring off, of blocks
Joining of blocks with quilt-as-you-go method
Complete article with pillowcase method.
Edging with cords.

## REQUIREMENTS

basic quilting supplies for the class and sewing machine
$30 \times 30 \mathrm{~cm}$ foundation material (like calico or sheeting)
$30 \times 30 \mathrm{~cm}$ batting
backing material
lots of scraps which have a stained glass effect or 'other' matching material
Folded strips of black or matching 'other' colour
black or 'other' matching thread
