

## **ALET DAVY :TEXTURED LOG-CABINS:**

Folded strips of material are stitched, on foundation pieces of material, to form different log-cabin designs. The different pieces are then joined together with quilt as you go method.

No batting or other quilting is required, because there are more than 3 layers.

Because this method requires quite a lot of material, light, medium and dark colours of recycled material from curtains, tablecloths, scarves and clothes can be used. The more texture, the better. Lots of different examples will be shown.

Techniques: Foundation strip stitching

Joining blocks with quilt-as-you-go method

Squaring off, of blocks

Attaching of bindings

## **REQUIREMENTS**

basic quilting supplies for the class and sewing machine

1/2m sturdy material (like calico or sheeting) for foundation

backing material for each block

20x20cm centre material (bright)

lots and lots of folded textured material (light, medium and dark)

matching thread - grey, beige etc
