

DANÉL MULLER - STEMS AND VINES

Workshop in the use of strips to enhance any quilt, hand, or machine. How to cut strips on the bias, when to use strips cut on the length and the last element, how to make a woven heart using strips.

This class will give you the technical expertise to use and utilize strips to create sturdy vines, delicate stems and woven elements.

Students to bring:

Cotton thread for piecing in a neutral colour, to shade with your fabric.

Invisible thread

Sewing Machine with all the power cords, foot pedals, oiled and ready to work.

Scissors - Small sharp point fabric scissors

Rotary cutter with ruler and cutting mat.

Bias makers in different sizes.

Bias tape in different sizes (optional)







Small pressing table (12" x 12" piece of wood covered with cotton batting and fabric)

Iron.

Fabric:

The choice of colour is yours, but for the best results, keep to the prescribed colour values (light and dark)

- Light - Background - $\frac{3}{4}$ m
- Medium - Vines - $\frac{3}{4}$ m in 2 different fabrics to liven up.
- Medium - Flowers and weaving - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
- Dark - Flowers and weaving - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
- Dark - stems and vines - $\frac{1}{2}$ m
