

LEANNE STEWART - CLARENS 2023 HOURGLASS JELLY ROLL QUILT:

Using a jelly roll that has an equal number of light and dark strips, you will create a beautiful hourglass quilt learning the following techniques:

- How best to use a jelly roll
- Method of making a quick easy quilt
- Colour value differences
- Strip piecing
- Half square triangles - the quick easy way
- Quatre square triangles - the easy way
- Accurate measuring
- Nesting the seams for perfectly matched seams
- Pressing the seams in the correct direction
- Different quilting designs for a jelly roll quilt
- Quick easy quilt binding

LIST OF REQUIREMENTS:

Fabric:

- 1 Jelly roll (or 40 x 42" wide x 2.5"strips) 20 light and 20 dark. Jelly Rolls will be available in Clarens at Alae's shop.
- 30cm solid light to match Jelly Roll
- 30 cm solid dark to match Jelly Roll
- 60cm binding
- 2m x 150 wide backing

Thread:

- Neutral (cream or grey) thread to go with all fabrics or a dark thread and a light thread

Rulers:

- Usual 24 inch quilters ruler

Needles:

- Universal sewing machine size 80 needles

Machine Feet:

- $\frac{1}{4}$ inch sewing machine foot
- Walking foot

Thread:

- Threads to match Jelly Roll
- Light and Medium Grey to go with all fabrics

Notions:

- Spray Starch
- Pins
- Sewing Needles
- Fabric Marker (Blue fabric erasable/soluble pen, white pencil and HB pencil)
- Clean and Oiled Sewing Machine and all accessories
- Scissors (big and small sharp ones)
- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting Mat
- Iron and Portable ironing board (if you have)
