

## SUE CAMERON - Luscious Little Landscape

In this full day class, students will learn the basics involved in stitching a pieced landscape. Some of the techniques that will be learned are curved piecing, inset seams and more. Many tips and tricks from how to make a landscape quilt pattern from a picture to how to iron landscape quilts, will be learned. Two size options will be available for this class.

### Requirements List

Sewing machine, in good working order

Quarter inch foot

Open toe appliqué foot

Cream/white machine stitching thread

Bobbin filled with this thread

Medium grey machine stitching thread

Bobbin filled with this thread

### Basic Sewing Supplies

Lots of pins

Fabric Scissors

Paper Scissors

Cutting mat

Rotary cutter with spare blade

Quilters Ruler

Pencil and notebook

Pritt or fabric glue stick

Chalk marking pencil or white tailors chalk

B Pencil and sharpener

### Fabric Requirements

All fabric must be 100% cotton. It is best to use hand dyed fabrics or batiks as commercial prints create very harsh lines in your landscape. Fabric sizes are for the larger size quilt. You will need considerably less fabric for the smaller size.

The following fabrics can be fat quarters and there should be at least 4 pieces

Very light greyish blue - almost white

White

5 Grey fabrics in medium to medium-light shades - best with a lilac undertone - you will need to choose 3 of these.

A variety of green fabrics from light to dark in strips about 6 inches wide. Try to bring at least 15 options to choose from

At least two options of rust brown fabric for the foreground - medium to dark

A strip of navy also 5 inches wide
